## Queen Candidates

The 62nd annual Waterama celebration will be held July 27 - July 30 and applications are now being accepted for the next Waterama Queen.

All interested Waterama Queen candidates must meet the following requirements:

- Be a current Pope County Resident
- Be a 2017 Junior or Senior at Minnewaska Area High School, or locally home schooled
- Be at least 16 years old, but no older than 20.

A limit of 21 candidates will be allowed to vie for the title of Waterama Queen. In the event that more than 21 applicants are received, all applicants will be invited to a special event which will include a briefing on the requirements of the Waterama Royalty and individual interviews with a panel of judges. The judges will provide recommendations to narrow the field to 21 candidates. Any applicant wishing to be removed as a candidate may do so within 24 hours of their interview by contacting a member of the Waterama Queen Committee.
